








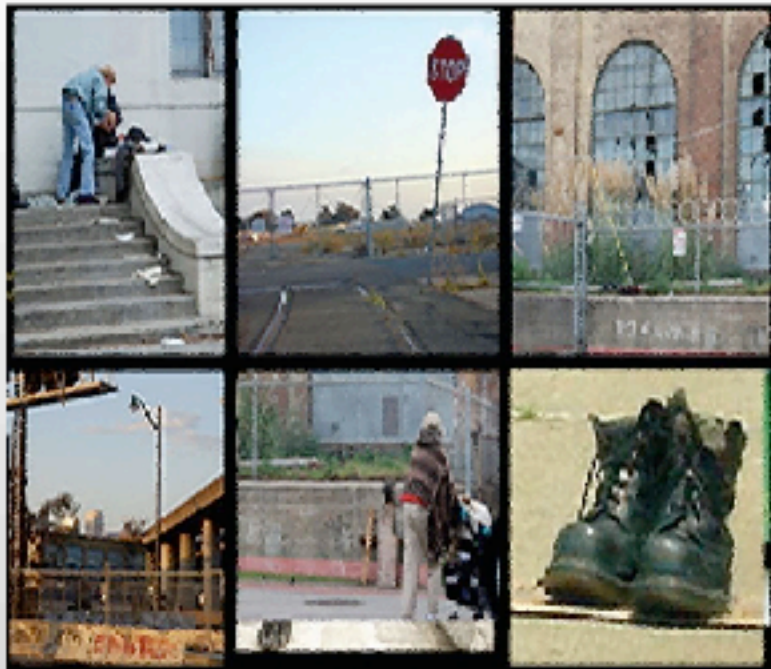

there would be Charity.**

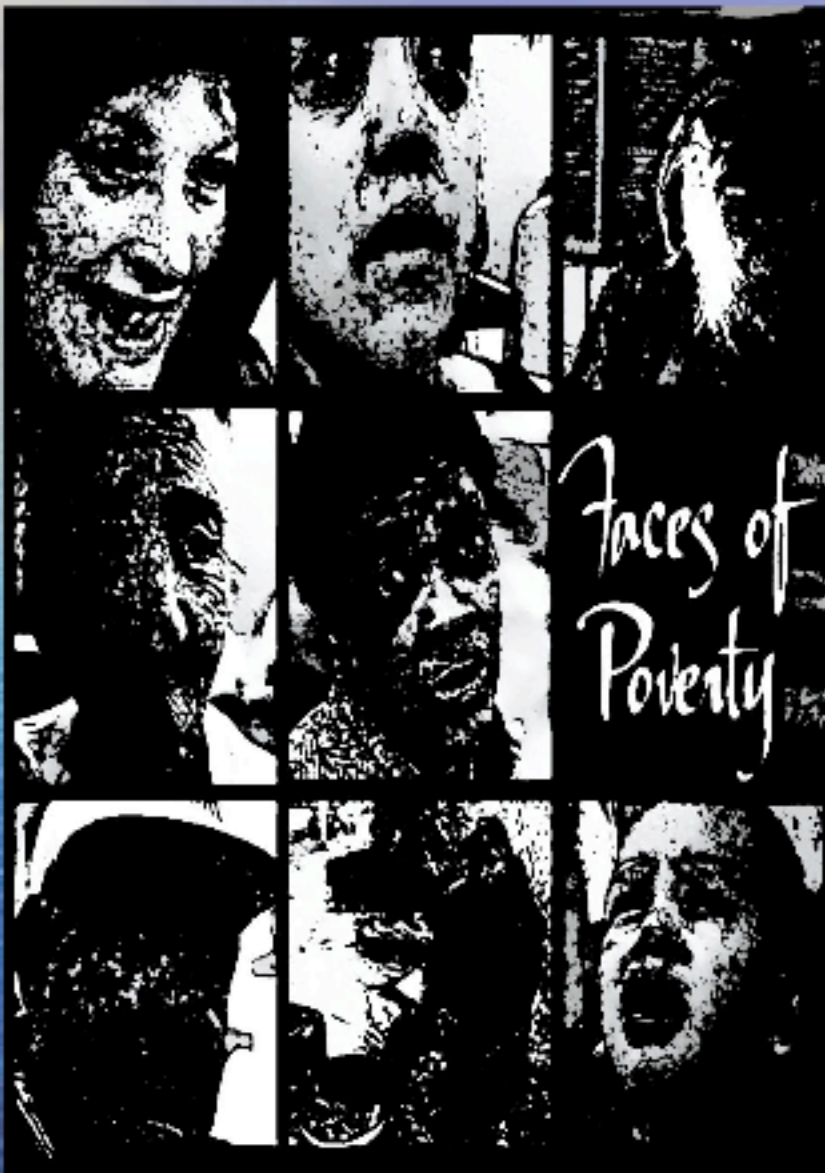
**Charity

And in the United States of America today.**

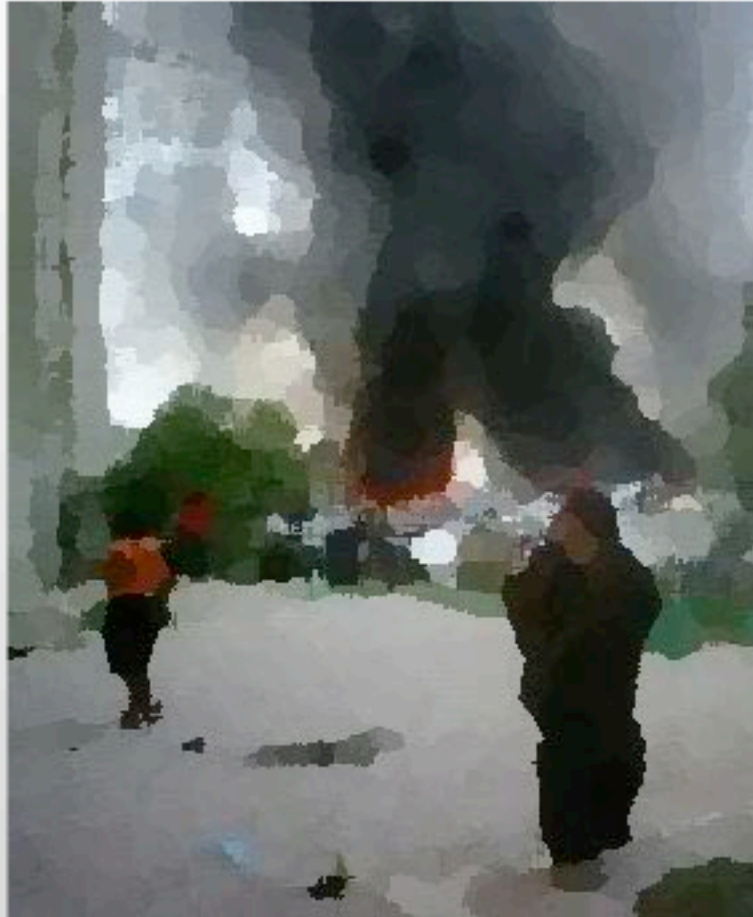


There is no peace

same problem.


There is no peace

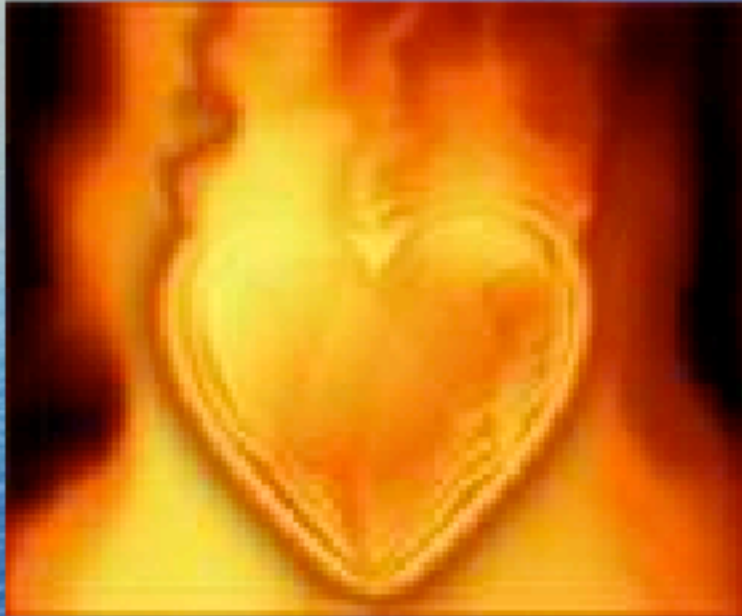


